

2024 Scholarship Application Deadline, March 15, 2024

Eligibility Requirements:

- Scholarships are **only** available to active cooperative members and immediate family living in the home, or current co-op employees and dependents. A copy of a current DSEC bill is required for members.
- Applicants must be high school seniors, college or vocational students who did not receive the scholarship prior to high school graduation, or those wishing to continue their education after an extended absence.
- Scholarships are available for attendance at state supported universities, private universities, junior colleges, or trade schools.

Scholarship Application Requirements

- The completed application is due to DSEC offices no later than **March 15th**. Awards will be announced no later than 60 days from this date.
- Applicant must provide 3 letters of recommendation from 3 different sources. Only
 one from any school employee (this includes teachers, coaches, counselors and
 other school district or college staff. *Ex: a letter from a teacher and a letter from a
 coach will not be accepted)*, one from employer, one from community activities
 leader, church, mentor, etc. Letters of recommendation from family members will
 not be accepted.
- High school students must submit an official 7-semester transcript (includes fall semester grades) and a dual credit transcript if applicable. College students must submit an official transcript of their most recently completed college courses.
- ACT and/or SAT test results. If these are included on the high school transcript, a separate copy isn't needed.
- A copy of most current DSEC bill.
- A recent photo (headshot preferred) to be used for media and social networks.
- A student resume including the following information: Academic honors and awards; school-related honors/club memberships/activities/offices/positions; Civic/church/volunteer/community activities and achievements; and work experience. (see example)



General

- Payment will be made when the recipient has fulfilled eligibility requirements and enrollment has been verified. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the school through the registrar's office. Your schedule and proof of enrollment must be received by DSEC no later than **August 1st** for the fall semester.
- Refund of payment will become due to DSEC should the recipient fail to enter school as enrolled, fail to complete the semester, or withdraw while eligible for the scholarship award.
- Scholarship award will be divided equally between semesters.
- Your Spring schedule and fall transcript reflecting hours and GPA for the previous semester are due to our office no later than **January 2nd** for the spring semester. The second semester payment will be made when the recipient continues to meet the eligibility criteria below:

* Maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.0 based on a 4-point system.

- * Be considered by the registrar to be a full-time student.
- Scholarships are awarded to eligible applicants one time only.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on the following primary criteria: current GPA; academic honors; school activities; and community engagement. Secondary criteria includes: current written essay; class rank, SAT/ACT scores; and recommendation letters.

Recipients

Recipients must maintain at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average on a 4.00 scale and be considered by the registrar to be a full-time student.
